Ride Information:

*This is a Fully Police Escorted Ride.

All Police Department Motor Units attending will lead and be a part of the procession (Not Escort the procession), followed "in order" by Members of the Blue Knights, Attending Law Enforcement Motorcycle Clubs(LEMC's), Non LEMC Law Enforcement Officer Riders & Invited Guests.

*Ride Registration at Cheesequake on the day of the ride (Arrive earlier) or Pre-Register by scanning the "TicketTailor link" (on this form) with your cell phone & follow the instructions. Early arrival for ride day registration is strongly recommended...

*There will be ride registration passes issued to All Registrants & Parking Stickers will be handed out at the meeting location(Cheesequake) on the morning of the ride which are to be placed in the center of the Motorcycles Headlight.(Not Necessary for marked Police Bikes)

*There will be signs at the staging area on the light poles in the parking lot indicating where each group or guest should line up for the ride as follows: Marked PD Motor Units, Blue Knights, Law Enforcement Motorcycle Clubs "LEMC", Law Enforcement Officers "LEO" (non MC club members in Law Enforcement) & Invited Guests.

*There will be "No Parking Zones" set up around the perimeter of Rockefeller Center reserved for the motorcycles with parking passes in this procession.

*Once we arrive at Rockefeller Center, riders will proceed to the end of 48th Street and start lining up their bikes at 5th Ave IN ORDER in "Zipper Formation" on both sides of the street from 48th St & 5th Ave down to 6th Ave (not starting in the middle of 48th St or anywhere else along 48th Street). Overflow parking will be on the East side of 6th Ave between 47th & 49th Streets and riders will deliver the Toys to the Rockefeller Center Toy Box (in a Line Formation starting at the Blue Knights Ambulance after unloading the toys) located in the entrance of Rockefeller Plaza which is located directly behind the Christmas Tree. Rockefeller Center Security usually gives us special access to go behind the barriers and take photos under the tree and above the Ice Skating Rink but due to security issues they may not this year. There are rest rooms on the lower level of Rockefeller Plaza and food & beverage shops as well and the NYPD DEA Canteen will be on hand & parked on the 48th Street...

*BRING YOUR EZ PASS for the ride home!

*This ride is for EXPERIENCED RIDERS ONLY!!

** WEATHER:

This event will end by approximately 2:00-2:30pm. Therefore if there is NO rain or snow forecasted on the MORNING of the ride, the ride is ON! Ride Donations are non refundable if ride is cancelled and the proceeds will still be given to NYPD & NJSP charities.

*If rain or snow IS forecasted AFTER 4:00pm on the day of the ride, the ride is ON!

*If rain or snow IS forecasted BEFORE 4:00pm on the day of ride, the ride is CANCELLED!

RIDE DONATIONS FOR POLICE CHARITIES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED DUE TO RIDE CANCELLATION.
