**Greetings and salutations my fellow knights. Spring has arrived, let's get the oil running through our engines. Here is the route from New York to Montana (Blue Knights International Conference). Before I post it, I just want to mention a few things:**

- 1) This is not a Blue Knight sanctioned ride, just a group of friends taking a ride together.**
- 2) The route milage was based on information gleamed from Google Maps.**
- 3) The stars attributed to any of the lodging selections, was obtained on Google Maps.**
- 4) The cost per night at any of the lodging selection was obtained on Google, during the month of November 2025, it is unknown what the actual cost will be in July 2026. ## **COGNITIVE FATIGUE AND THE STRATEGIC STOP**

**Hello All,**

**Hope everyone is doing well as we enter the 2026 riding season! With the International Convention, conference conventions, and all the bike weeks nationwide on the horizon, this seems like the perfect time to discuss ‘cognitive fatigue’ and the ‘strategic stop’. While you’re on the road for long periods of time, laying down mile after mile, there are certain things that happen to you as a rider. The most common is the ‘goal trap’ - we start to feel the sooner we arrive at our destination, the sooner we can relax, perhaps enjoy a beer with our brother and sister Blue Knights, maybe have that steak we’ve been craving. While these thoughts are rolling through our minds, we push the pace. We sometimes ignore our immediate hunger and need for fluids. We think this is a test of our man or womanhood and shows a sign of resilience. The reality is it may begin to cloud our situational awareness and capacity to react to immediate situations. Some of the signs we may want to look out for while riding are shifting within your lane, not remembering the last few miles you rode, missing turns and exits (even when using GPS), having muscle cramps, excessive blinking with our eyes feeling heavy, yawning and feeling numbness or tingling in your hands or feet. Medical research has confirmed “The act of piloting demands a heavy data processing load”. Other bikes, cars, trucks, stop signs, bridges, those sharp turns all play a part in that data load. Long haul truckers, airline pilots, cruise ship pilots and even our elite military fighter pilots all feel it. By the time your muscles feel the load, your brain is already saturated with sensory overload. This is when decision errors start.**

**Now, you may ask yourself – “What can one do to get past this?”. It’s as simple as stopping, taking a break. Some say a minimum of 15 mins to 30 mins for every 1.5 hours of riding. Remove your helmet and drink plenty of water. What this does is reset your ability to observe and react. So, when you get back on your bike and hit the road, you feel more alert. Your bike feels lighter and you begin to feel the road in front of you. This makes your ride more enjoyable, memorable and most of all SAFE. In closing I’d like to quote Ralph Waldo Emerson. “It’s not about the destination; it’s about the journey”. And we all want to make it a good one. I’m looking forward to seeing everyone in May at the Tri-State Presidents Meeting in Millville, New Jersey. As always, be good and be safe and Ride with Pride.**
