- 3) The stars attributed to any of the lodging selections, was obtained on Google Maps.**
- 4) The cost per night at any of the lodging selection was obtained on Google, during the month of November 2025, it is unknown what the actual cost will be in July 2026. You are responsible for making your own reservation. I just included the name of the locations in the town, city, village, hamlet we are staying in for the night.**
- 5) Your dining selection is up to you; there are several different choices at each location.**
- 6) In Montana there were not too many choices, I tried my best to include what I could.**

7) Each day we have to ride at minimum 450 Miles / 8 Hrs. Not including gas/lunch stops. We have a total of approximately 2200 Miles to cover in 5 days.

I still have to plot the return trip from Montana to New York. It must likely, will be the same locations on the return trip.

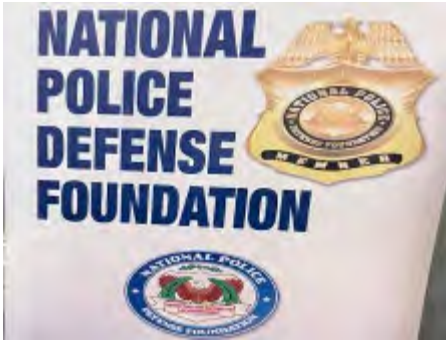

□ Expansion to All Conflicts: Following World War I, the holiday was expanded to commemorate American service members who lost their lives in all American wars, including WWII, Korea, Vietnam, and subsequent conflicts.

□ The Difference: Memorial Day honors those who died in military service, whereas Veterans Day (celebrated in November) honors all military veterans, both living and deceased. (*YouTube).

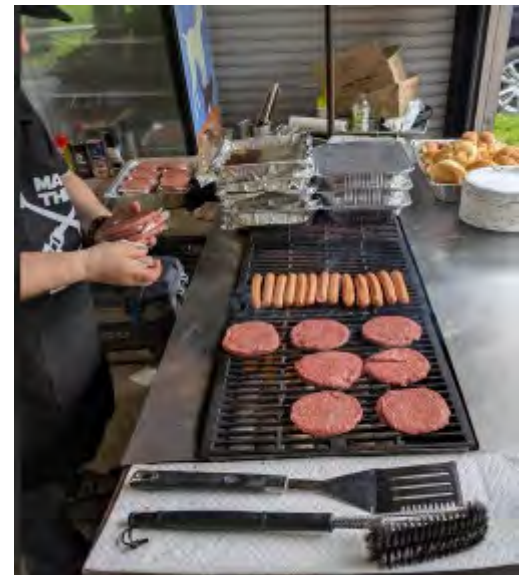

As we embark into riding season, I would like to ask a few questions of all our members. Don't get nervous. Easy, but thoughtful questions. Back before the dawn of cell phones, how many of us remembered telephone numbers? And if we didn't, we had that little phone book with phone numbers in it. Then came the cell phone and out went the need for this little book or the need to remember phone numbers. They're all in the contact app on our cell phone. But now I ask another question... What if you lost your phone? Can you contact a friend or a loved one? Or worse yet, if you're injured or fall ill, can anyone else get access to your phone to contact that same friend or loved one? If the answer is 'no', well here is an idea. Most of us in our Law Enforcement career have had business cards. Some may still have them today. Take one and on the back write some basic information. The same type of information you may find on a military dog tag - name and blood type if you know it. Any allergies or medical conditions you may have. Then a few emergency contact numbers - maybe your significant other, children, maybe even your best buddy. Throwing all the 'God forbids' at it, if something should happen, you or someone else can get in touch with those important to you. Maybe even laminate the card so, if you get caught in the rain, it will be somewhat protected. At the last Tri-State Conference Meeting, a few members mentioned they already do this.

At our next BOG meeting, I ask for your support for the new BOG By-Law proposal designating our Vice-Chairman as the primary point-of-contact and liaison for cultivating and developing future International Convention bids. This is an important job for the Club, that really deserves the dedicated attention of a BOG Executive Board member.

That said, the 2028 International Convention bid deadline has passed with no submissions. Responsibility now shifts from the BOG to the International Board of Directors; please encourage any interested chapters or conferences to contact their International Rep. immediately. Hopefully, the BOD will be able to secure a host before our meeting in Calgary.

For those that are not aware, the Convention guidelines have been recently revised. The new 2026 version is posted on the International Website on the Convention Committee page. It is important that all Chapter Presidents review those IC guidelines and give their feedback to the IC Committee. Particularly if there are things in there that are preventing you from putting in a bid to host.

Lastly, I would be remiss if I didn't add a reminder for donations toward the Special Fund. Last year we paid out over \$12k in qualified claims to injured members or surviving families and we only took in about \$4k in donations.

If your chapter has not yet donated for 2026, please do, and please do make it a priority to chip in each year. The Special Fund is there for you and your members and we ask all chapters for your continued support with a voluntary annual contribution of just \$1 per member.

It has truly been an honor to represent the BOG and serve as your Chairman these past 2 years. Thank you all for your support.
