RECRUITMENT PAMPHLET

Dear Members of the Tri-State Conference,

In an effort to assist you in your endeavors to recruit new members, the Conference has developed this new pamphlet and made it available for you to download, customize with your chapter information and print as many copies as you need. It is meant to be tri-fold so it is easy to carry and hand out to potential new members.

There are a few simple instructions for you to properly add your chapter information and print the pamphlet.

Since you are reading this, you have step one completed by opening the file. To add your chapter information, simply go to the fillable box under "Your Local Chapter" and type in the information. The more you type, the smaller the print gets so it will fit in the box.

Then save the file to your computer using another name for the file such as Chapter?Pamphlet. You can then delete this page (page 1) if you are confident on how to print properly or save this as a blank copy also for future reference.

Then got to File and select Print.

When your Print Options open, under "Pages to Print" select "All" if you have deleted this page OR if you have not deleted this page, select "Page" then type in "2 - 3" so that your pamphlet will print without this instruction page.

Then click the box "Print on both sides of paper" and then select "Flip on short edge".

Don't forget to set how many copies you want to print but it is suggested you do a test run of just one copy first to make sure your settings are correct.

Best of luck and we hope this pamphlet aide you in your recruitment efforts.

<u>MEMBERSHIP CATEGORIES</u> <u>IN GENERAL:</u>

REGULAR MEMBER

Any person working or retired from a "Governmental Law Enforcement Agency or Department" that is or was employed on a fulltime basis of 32 hours per week or more under normal conditions.

ASSOCIATE MEMBER

Any person working for a "Governmental Law Enforcement Agency or Department" that is employed on a part-time basis of less than 32 hours per week but more than 96 hours per year under normal conditions.

HONORARY MEMBER

Chapters may welcome persons into their chapter as Honorary members that do not otherwise qualify. Chapters are limited to no more than 1 Honorary Member for each 10 Regular and/or Associate Members based on their annual roster.

MEMBER-AT-LARGE (MAL)

Those members that qualify as a regular member but do not reside within 50 miles of any existing chapters may request membership directly via the International without joining a chapter. Status must be confirmed annually by your local conference. Such members will be required to join a chapter should one become available in your area.

Special Notes: All Regular, Associate and Members-at-Large MUST be employed by, or retired from a "Governmental Law Enforcement Agency or Department", have statutory powers of arrest and receive monetary compensation for such. Private Enforcement officers, volunteer positions, elected or appointed positions may not qualify. Further membership restrictions may apply. Check the International website or contact either the Tri-State Conference or Local Chapter for more information.
